designing living objects

Cork is a natural material with exceptional environmental qualities: a renewable resource, recyclable, non toxic and durable, with excellent physical and mechanical properties, which is not extracted through a process of cutting (as for example happens with trees). The cork oak's capacity for regeneration is enormous, even without using chemical herbicides, fertilizers or irrigation. At the end of nine years the bark is reborn and the cork is soon ready to be harvested once again through a careful manual process, without damaging the cork oak or the environment.





Lagarta cork modular seat

CONCEPT

Lagarta is an interactive, playful infinite modular seating system. You can always add another ball to the body, fitting the hollow in the curved part of the next ball. Lagarta modular seat provides a sensorial experience in a get-together scene. The Lagarta seat is made of agglomerated expanded cork, the most sustainable kind of cork composites and finished with water based varnish.

Vinco

CONCEPT

Vinco chair offers a sophisticated feel with a natural touch, providing a unique sensorial experience with cork. The creases in "Vinco" form a volumetric structure out of a flat board, made from a sandwich of natural agglomerate cork and rubber cork. The chair is ready to use just by assembling the board on the polished steel structure, without any glue or screws.

Puf String cork seat

CONCEPT

Puf String is a playful seat taking to the limit the plastic and visual possibilities of rubber cork (a special cork composite with natural rubber). The Puf string is shaped like a wave using joint screws as assembly and is fasten with a rubber cork belt strip. The final result is an original piece, benefiting from the rubber cork characteristics.

Wallcork cork wall covering

CONCEPT

Combining cork texture and vibrant patterns, Wall Cork provides you an innovative and visually appealing wall covering and an all-embracing sensorial experience. This natural cork with a textile base also fulfils an acoustic and thermal insulating function like no other material, and is equally safe and washable. Can be used as panel or as a total wall covering.

Corqui cork lounge chair

The Corqui Lounge Chair concept combines attractive aesthetic lines with a comfortable seat made from cork. The cork sensorial characteristics are predominant when experiencing the seating or simply touching its surface. Corqui can be made with both natural or black agglomerate cork.

CONCEPT

The One Sixty Four cork sideboard is the name for a piece with 164 perfect holes. The black holes and the larger grain scale of the cork texture surface adds a very original look and feel to the sideboard. One Sixty Four is made of a natural agglomerate cork and black waterproof MDF sandwich.

Black Flower

CONCEPT

The Black Flower is a cork sideboard piece with a flower illustration in bas-relief, giving it a special refine texture. The black agglomerate cork is a natural chromatic change derived from a non toxic process of "boiling" the cork in high temperatures, which results in a beautiful black "roasted" looking.


Beja cork sideboard




Topography cork trivet


